Notice to Residents and Tenants in Central Holmes Beach Neighborhoods surrounding Spring Lake

As part of the City's ongoing Capital Improvement Program for Stormwater; the City's Contractor, Woodruff & Son's, will be installing stormwater filtration/percolation systems in June and July 2016 along and within the City's rights of way in the open and/or grassed areas adjacent to the edge of asphalt. Driveways and heavily landscaped areas will not be disturbed unless absolutely necessary to ensure proper drainage. Existing drainage inlets and pipes will be repaired/replaced/modified as many of the pipes are failing at the joints

. The improvements will be installed along the following Streets:

- 68th Street (Pipe cleaning and maintenance only from Gulf Drive to Palm Drive)
- 71st Street (Pipe cleaning and repairs only from Gulf Drive to Palm Drive)
- 71st Court (Pipe Cleaning and repairs only from Palm Drive to Marina Drive)
- 72nd Street (Replace storm pipes at Holmes Blvd intersection)
- Holmes Blvd (Between 67th Street and Clark Drive)
- Palm Drive (Between 73rd Street and 68th Street)
- Clark Drive (Between Holmes Blvd and Palm Drive)

The construction activities will last approximately 1-2 months. The construction areas will be excavated and filled within the same work day to ensure that no hazards are left open overnight or over the weekends.

The many benefits of these improvements include but are not limited to the following:

- Flood Reduction;
- Elimination of sediment and pollutants discharging to the Bay (an outstanding Florida Water Body);
- Replenishment of fresh water lens (groundwater supply);
- Reduction in long term maintenance of the City's stormwater management system;
- Long term reduction in Storm Water Utility Fees and Assessments.

Please take note: the City Engineer will be conducting neighborhood meetings on May 31st, 2016 at 5:30pm and June 21st, 2016 at 5:30pm. The meetings will commence at Spring Lake Park. Opportunity will be provided to discuss any concerns that residents may have.
