What to know when having a Wedding in Holmes Beach

PLEASE BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR WHILE VISITING HOLMES BEACH – OUR PARADISE

- Name of Bride & Groom
- Date & Time of Wedding
- Location of Wedding
- Emergency contact name & phone number for Wedding Party

When using our beautiful beaches, please comply with:

- Noise curfew is from 10pm to 7am every night.
- Local and federal ordinances/laws protecting sea turtles (city ordinance Ch. 66, Article II, Div 1, Sec. 66-31)
 - From May 1st to October 31st each year.
 - Remove all furniture, temporary structures, beach chairs, etc. from the beach nightly
- No alcohol or Glass bottles are allowed on any Manatee County public beaches.
- Parking laws and ordinances, look for any 'No Parking' signs in front of and behind your car when you park.
- Sky Lanterns are prohibited per Florida State Statute 590.10 'Disposing of Lighted Substances'

Vehicle Safety Tips

- Lock your car and carry your keys with you. Don't keep an extra key "hidden" anywhere on the car, thieves know where to look.
- When away from the car keep all valuables in your trunk, not in view.
- If your car's cigarette lighter is visible from the outside of the car, keep the cigarette lighter in it. If a criminal looks into your vehicle and sees a missing cigarette lighter they may think that you use some type of power adapter such as a GPS unit or cell phone.
- Suction cup marks on your dash or window provide clues to thieves that you may have a GPS unit or other valuable device in your vehicle.
- Remember to also hide your garage door opener, leaving it visible may provide the criminal with an opportunity to gain access to your home.
- Please report suspicious vehicles and/or persons in your neighborhood immediately, please don't wait until the next day.
- NEVER leave your pet(s) unattended in your car, even for a short time.
